What things can we do after we have fallen out that make things better?



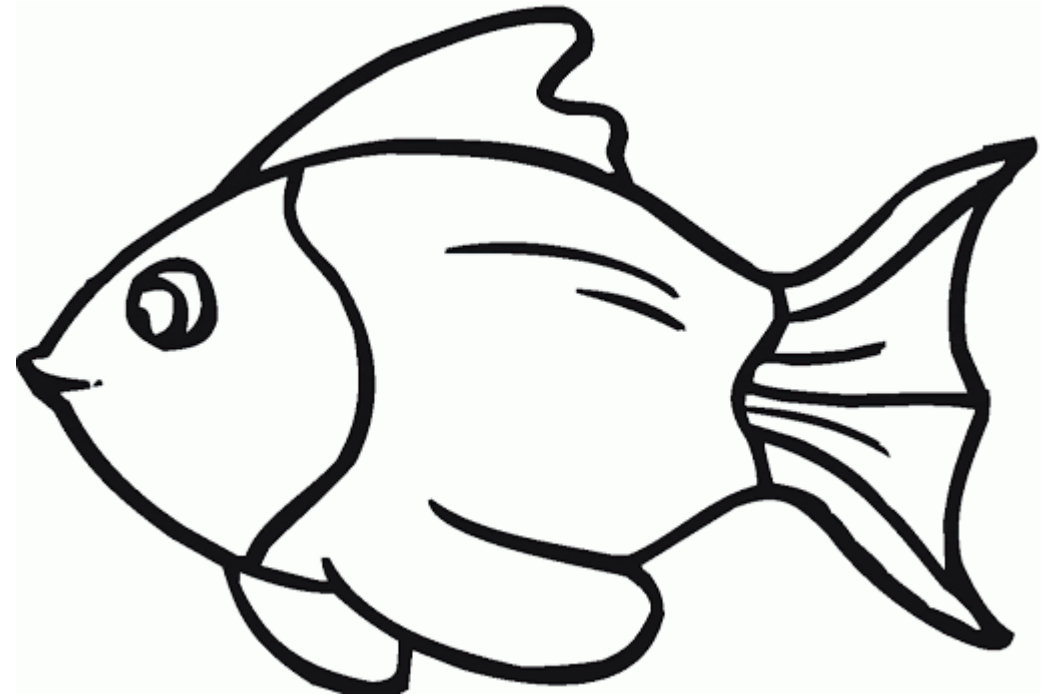
Say sorry to God for the things that we have done wrong this week.

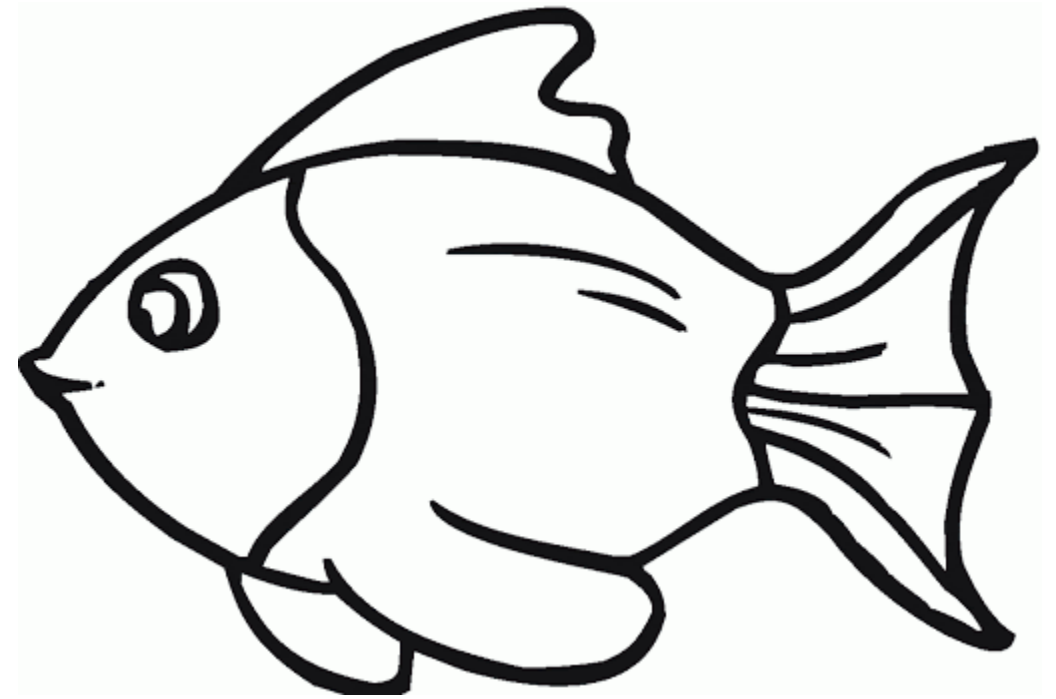
# The Right & The Wrong
